WALK-IN COOLER: DREAM BECAME REALITY

Northern Arizona's largest walk-in cooler is now completed and will provide food security for the 180 Agencies we serve. This project became possible through generous donations from Forest Highlands Foundation, Arizona Cardinals Charities, Margot A. Staple Foundation, Coconino County Board of Supervisors, World Emergency Relief, American Culinary Federation (Chef & Child), and individuals who answered our call for help last year. A "cooler celebration" party and ribbon-cutting was held on April 19, 2004. The party was attended by approximately 50 people, including representatives from the above organizations. Plaques were awarded to these donors at the party, with duplicate plaques mounted on the outside of the cooler. A larger plaque is also mounted that lists the silver, gold, and platinum donors for amounts of \$50, \$75 and \$100, respectively. You can view these plaques when you visit the food bank! This cooler will allow the N.A.F.B. to maintain proper storage temperatures ensuring product quality and safety.



FEINSTEIN CHALLENGE COMPLETED

\$15,000 RECEIVED! THANK YOU, FLAGSTAFF!



N.A.F.B. and Flagstaff organizations put a major effort into this food drive challenge. Each spring for the past 7 years, philanthropist Alan Shawn Feinstein has issued a donation challenge to all non-profit/anti-hunger organizations. The challenge is that the participating agencies can collect a share of \$1 million dollars, based on the relative percentage of their incoming donations during the months of March and April, 2004. NAFB had the cooperation of several businesses in town rising to the challenge. The hands-down, top contributor was W.L.Gore & Associates Inc., with over 7500 lbs. of mixed foods and commodities donated, followed by Christ's Church of Flagstaff, who held a dry cereal collection at weekend services. Thanks also go out to Diamond Dodge/Chrysler, Diamond Hyundai, S.W.C.A., Inc., the Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, Kinsey School, Knoles School, and Stockmen's Bank, all of whom allowed us to place collection bins at their location and/or collected food for the N.A.F.B.



COCONINO COUNTY FAIR—SEPT. 3-6, 2004—"FISHING FOR FUN-ds"

N.A.F.B. will have a 13' x 25' pool in the SW corner of the fairgrounds. Home Depot is supplying the decking, AZ Game & Fish is supplying the trout and fishing gear, and Wal-Mart is supplying two bicycles for raffle prizes. We are seeking business sponsors that wish to display their community involvement in helping N.A.F.B. in its mission to help the less fortunate. Corporate banners are available at \$275 and will be proudly displayed around the fishing pool. Please supply your business artwork to us by August 16th. UPDATE: "WOOD FOR WINTER WARMTH"

With the wood donated over the past 3 seasons, the **Wood For Winter Warmth** program has been able to supply a total of 602 cords, or 1,202,231 pounds of split pine to needy families. Additionally, several semi-truck loads went to senior centers who distribute the wood to even more families. With the warm weather we began having, as well as the woodpile dwindling, the wood project was closed down at the end of March. We are stockpiling for the next winter season, however and would love to keep receiving wood through the summer and fall. It is a tax-deductible donation for you, and comforting warmth for others. We were very blessed to have a lot of help from volunteers, which is an ongoing, critical need. The wood bank is scheduled to reopen October 1, 2004.
